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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
THE GALLERY HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INCORPORATED

STATE OF LOUISIANA

PARISH OF EAST BATON ROUGE

BE IT KNOWN, that on this 29 day of January, 1979, in the Year of Our Lord, One Thousand, Nine Hundred Seventy Nine,

BEFORE ME, G. Allen Walsh, Notary Public, in and for the Parish and State aforesaid, personally came and appeared, the subscriber hereto, who declared to me, Notary, in the presence of the undersigned competent witnesses, that availing himself of the provisions of the Business Corporation Law of Louisiana, he does hereby organize a corporation in accordance with the following articles of incorporation, to-wit:

ARTICLE I.

The name of the corporation is The Gallery Homeowners Association, Inc.

ARTICLE II.

The purpose of the corporation is to engage in any lawful activity for which corporations may be formed under the Business Corporation Law of Louisiana.

ARTICLE III.

The total authorized capital stock of this corporation is Ten (10) shares of common stock, without fixed or par value. The right to fix the consideration for issuance of shares without fixed or par value is reserved for the shareholders.

ARTICLE IV.

Shareholders shall have pre-emptive rights.

ARTICLE V.

All officers of the corporation shall be elected by the director.

ARTICLE VI.

All directors of this corporation shall be elected by the shareholders.

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ARTICLE VII.

In the election of directors, each shareholder of record shall have the right to multiply the number of votes to which he is entitled by the number of directors to be elected, and to cast all such votes for one candidate, or distribute them among any two or more candidates.

ARTICLE VIII.

If shareholder action or approval is required by law in connection with the amendment of these articles or any merger, consolidation, transfer of corporate assets or dissolution or involving the corporation, such action or approval shall be taken or given only upon the affirmative vote of not less than $66 \frac{2}{3} \%$ of the number of shares entitled to vote on the particular question.

ARTICLE IX.

The Board of Directors has no authority to make or alter by laws affixing their qualifications, classification, number, term of office of compensation, such authority being reserved to the shareholders.

ARTICLE X.

Whenever the affirmative vote of shareholders is required to authorize or constitute corporate action, the consent in writing to such action signed only by shareholders holding that proportion of the total voting power on the question which is required by law or by these Articles of Incorporation, which requirement is higher, shall be sufficient for the purpose, without necessity for meeting of shareholders.

ARTICLE XI.

The number of directors of the corporation shall be such number, not less than (5), as shall be designated in the by-laws, or if not so designated, as shall be elected from time to time by the shareholders.

Any director absent from a meeting of the Board of Directors or any committee thereof may be represented by any other director or shareholder, who may cast the vote of the absent director according to the written instructions, general or special, of the absent director.

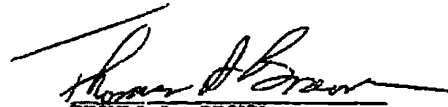

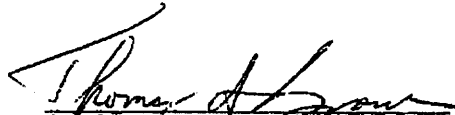
